Holding Statement: GE Proficy CIMPLICITY Vulnerability

On the 22nd of February 2022, a series of vulnerabilities affecting GE Proficy CIMPLICITY were made public by CISA. Successful exploitation of these vulnerabilities could allow an attacker to: (i) capture a connection session, resulting in disclosure of sensitive information; and (ii) achieve both code execution and local privilege escalation.

As part of our product security policy and protocols, we are evaluating all our products and solutions utilizing Proficy CIMPLICITY for potential impact(s) from these reported vulnerabilities. GE Gas Power PSIRT is also evaluating the updates related to the vulnerabilities for further possible actions as needed. We will continue to monitor developments and provide updates/recommendations related to the vulnerabilities to all stakeholders via our GE Gas Power Security Portal.
