Security Situation Statement: Response to Cyber concerns in current geopolitical context in the Middle East Region

Dear Customers,

We are aware of the ongoing geopolitical conflict and the possibility of emerging cyber threats in the Middle East Region.

GE Vernova Gas Power M&D is actively monitoring the situation and is assessing potential impact to our systems, services, and customer data.

Currently, On-Site-Monitor (OSM) operations in that region continue as normal, without any monitoring service disruptions.

As a part of our standard security practices:

- The OSMs are being continuously monitored through CrowdStrike for indicators of compromise (IOC).
- OSMs are patched according to our monthly cadence.
- High and Critical vulnerabilities are actively identified through Qualys and remediated.
- Only necessary services, ports, and protocols that are required for the OSM to operate are used.

Please rest assured that GE Vernova Gas Power M&D remains committed to maintaining the security, integrity, and availability of our systems and customer data. Should new circumstances arise, we will take appropriate actions and provide timely communication.
